I shall labor for the growth and strength of this Initiative — recruiting members, identifying future leaders, and promoting its work wherever honorable opportunity presents itself.

I shall contribute, according to my means, to sustain the work entrusted to our care.

#### **Of Confidentiality and Trust**

I shall hold in strict confidence those matters entrusted to me in the course of Board service, disclosing nothing deemed private or sensitive, except as law or solemn duty may require. Such obligation shall endure beyond my term of service.

#### **Of Ethical Conduct**

I shall conduct myself with integrity in all matters affecting the Madison–Lincoln Initiative. I shall avoid conflicts between personal interest and organizational duty, and where such conflicts may arise, I shall disclose them fully and refrain from participation in related deliberations or decisions.

I shall neither seek personal gain from my service nor permit private interest to outweigh the common good. I shall endeavor always to act fairly, transparently, and in good faith, mindful that the character of this Initiative rests upon the character of those who guide it.

In accepting this charge, I resolve to act not for self, but for the enduring cause of principled civic life and the preservation of our republic.
